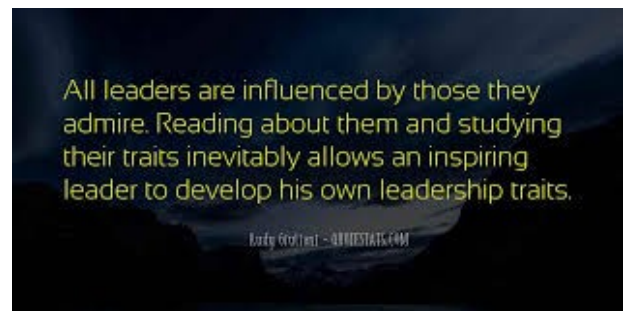
If you know any Brother who is ill or housebound, please let me know as we need to help and support our Brothers when ever and where ever we can. Your help in watching over them is important and appreciated.
